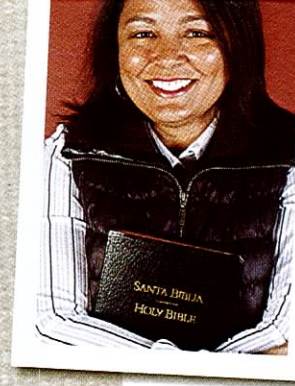

## *3 ways to put your love in action*

### **BECOME A VOLUNTEER**

Pregnancy centers are always looking for volunteers to be peer counselors, to serve on a Board of Directors, help raise funds or promote awareness through educational efforts. Whatever your gifts are, your local pregnancy center can use you. No experience is necessary – all you need is a heart to serve. You will be provided with the training you need to share the love of Christ and to help empower women and men to make positive life choices.

### **DONATE**

Your local pregnancy center is a non-profit agency and relies on financial contributions from individuals and businesses. There may also be a need for material resources to support the center and its services. Prayerfully consider how you may, through your gifts of love, be able to make a difference in the lives of many.

### **PRAY**

Regularly pray for your local center, its needs and work. Ask the Lord to open the eyes of mothers and fathers to see that they are not alone and that there is hope. Boldly pray that abortion would end.
